It was created by computer artist and programmer Carl Bass, who was on the staff of the Rand Corporation at the time. The name AutoCAD was created to differentiate it from the other programs in the CAD market. The name was chosen to imply "automated," because it did not require the user to interact with a graphics terminal. AutoCAD came in three versions: AutoCAD 3.0, 3.1, and 3.5. The operating system for these early versions was DOS, a graphical operating system created by Microsoft. AutoCAD 2016 has a 3D drawing feature which requires Project 2010 or newer. Unlike other programs, a 3D drawing uses three distinct dimensions, not two. For example, a 2D drawing's dimensions are measured along an X and Y axis. In the 3D drawing, the dimensions are in an X, Y, Z axis. The Z dimension is the distance from the drawing's origin point. The origin point can be anywhere within the drawing, but is most commonly at the bottom left. As of AutoCAD 2016, the 3D feature allows 3D coordinate inputs as well as the use of 3D or 2D drawings in 3D modeling. In 2012, Autodesk introduced the ability to enter and view AutoCAD drawing from within AutoCAD Revit. With this new feature, a project designed in Revit can be imported to AutoCAD and automatically converted to AutoCAD drawings. Autocad Student versions of AutoCAD 2000, 2002, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2018 and 2019 are available for free. Subscription versions of AutoCAD Autodesk also sells a subscription version of AutoCAD for individuals. A subscription is billed annually and allows the user to access the software and additional functionality in perpetuity. Subscriptions require a yearly recurring payment and are available in two types. Standard and premier subscriptions. According to Autodesk, a subscription is not a license to use the software, but access to additional functionality. The original subscription prices were higher than the use of other products such as AutoCAD LT. Subscriptions are not free, but once the subscription is purchased, the user is billed annually and the software is activated.
