NFL stats and analytics experts, Tom Silverstein and Mike Sando, have ranked the six best coaching stories in NFL history. 1. Atlanta Falcons After running a 14-2 record in 2016, the Atlanta Falcons were just 3-11 last season. In the first game of the 2018 season, Atlanta beat the Los Angeles Rams 45-35 and hit the playoffs for the first time in over a decade. As the team fell to 3-4, Atlanta received criticism for playing too conservatively. During a Week 7 loss to the Oakland Raiders, Atlanta offensive coordinator Kyle Shanahan was seen on the sidelines coaching the defense. He had been waiting for a midseason turnover before removing himself from play calling duties for the remainder of the season. Some Falcons fans joked that Shanahan would not be giving position coach Raheem Morris a token Super Bowl ride. Morris had previously been fired for coaching a 28-10 road loss to the Seattle Seahawks. However, as the year progressed, ownership made a late move to remove Morris. Shanahan was rewarded with the gig and has run the offense ever since. Atlanta now stands at 5-0 for the first time since 2013. 2. San Francisco 49ers When Jim Harbaugh was hired as head coach, many NFL analysts predicted that San Francisco would sign a veteran quarterback, a move that would greatly impact the future of the team. Entering 2014, quarterback Colin Kaepernick was having his most dominant season. The team decided to give Kaepernick a big contract, however the contract signed with Kaepernick in 2014 is now being called unfair and detrimental to Kaepernick’s ability to make a fair counteroffer. Kaepernick wanted the 49ers to renegotiate and offer him a contract similar to the one Drew Brees had at the time
